

Power cord quantity and plug type vary by regions.


1 **Remote Control**

- (1)(1)
- Switch the unit between ON and STANDBY mode.
- (2) **3**
- Select the play function.
- (3) SURR
- Adjust the surround ON/OFF.
- (4) **★** (BT)
- Select the Bluetooth mode. Press and hold the \$\mathbb{X}\$ (BT) button to activate the pairing function in Bluetooth mode or disconnect the existing paired Bluetooth device.
- (5) EQ
- Select a preset sound effect.
- ⑥ I◀4/▶►I
 - Skip to previous/next track in BT / USB mode.
- (7) VOL+/-(8) ▶||
- Increase/decrease the volume level. Play/pause/resume playback in BT / USB mode. Press and hold the ▶II button for 3s to enter setup menu. Confirm a selection.
- (9) BASS+/-Adjust bass level.
- (10) TREBLE+/- Adjust treble level.
- (11) **DIMMER+/-** Adjust display brightness.
- (12) (MUTE) Mute or resume the sound.




Replace the Remote Control Battery

- Press and slide the back cover to open the battery compartment of the remote control
- Insert two AAA size batteries (included). Make sure the (+) and (-) ends of the batteries match the (+) and (-) ends indicated in the battery compartment.
- Close the battery compartment cover.



- Do not mix old and new batteries;
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc) or rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Ni- MH, etc.) batteries.



Main Unit

- (1) (ON/OFF) button Switch the unit between ON and Standby mode.
- (2) **⇒** (**SOURCE**) button Select the play function.
- (3) VOL+/VOL- buttons Increase/decrease the volume level.
- Increase/decrease the volume I

 Display Window
- Show the current status.
- Remote Control Sensor
 Receive signal from the remote control.
- 6 Screws

Remove the screws then install the wall mounting screws into the back of the unit.

(7) **USB** Socket

Insert the USB device to play music.

(8) TYPE-C Socket

For the Dongle of wireless rear surround speaker.

- The surround kit needs to be purchased separately. This port can't be used to connect to other Type C devices.
- (9) **OPTICAL** Socket

Use to connect to the OPTICAL OUT socket on an external device.

(10) COAXIAL Socket

Use to connect to the COAXIAL OUT socket on an external device.


(11) HDMI OUT (TV eARC/ARC) Socket

The port for connecting a TV. The port supports the eARC/ARC HDMI feature, which allows the soundbar to play audio that originates on the connected TV.

(12) **HDMI IN (1/2)** Sockets


Two HDMI ports for connecting HDMI source devices, such as a DVD player, Blu-ray Disc™ player, or gaming console. Note that only one HDMI input is usable at a time.


(13) **AC~** Socket Connect to power supply.



Wireless Subwoofer

- AC~ Socket
 Connect to power supply.
- (2) PAIR button
 Press activate the pairing function between the main unit and the subwoofer.
- (3) PAIR Indicator
 Light stops blinking once the Subwoofer is paired with the Soundbar.

Setup Menu

- 1. During ON mode, press and hold the ▶II button for 3 seconds to open the menu.
- 2. Select the content with ► buttons.
- 3. Change the initial values for each of the settings with **VOL** +/- buttons.
- 4. Press the ►II button to confirm your selection and exit the settings.
- If no button is pressed within 15 seconds, the system will automatically exit the menu.
